The most important parts of a good fire protection is knowledge and awareness. Here can our tenants be of great help. We want to remind you now at Christmas time to take an extra look at the Advent candlestick and other candles before leaving the flat, as this is the greatest Christmas fire risk.



## FIRE DETECTOR

Your flat is equipped with fire detectors. Check regularly that it works. This is particularly important if you have been away for a while and the battery warning signal beep has stopped during this time. NEVER put a fire detector out of order.




## EVACUATION ROUTES

Areas such as stairwells, stairways, corridors, basement corridors and lift areas in the building are also usually escape routes. Therefore objects must not be stored here which can stand in the way of evacuation or anything that can catch fire or be used to start a fire. It is therefore not allowed to park bikes, put garbage, place doormats, placard, redecorate or even temporarily store things in such spaces.



## UNAUTHORIZED

Do not let unknown people in the property. If a lock does not work or a door is kept unlocked, make a fault report. If an unauthorized person is staying in the house, call SGS Jour, phone 031-40 42 90.



## CLOSE THE DOOR

A door with a door closer is partly to prevent smoke and fire spread. It is therefore important that you never put a door closer out of order or leave the door open.

Information on how the fire alarm in the building works is posted at the entrance by the fire panel.
